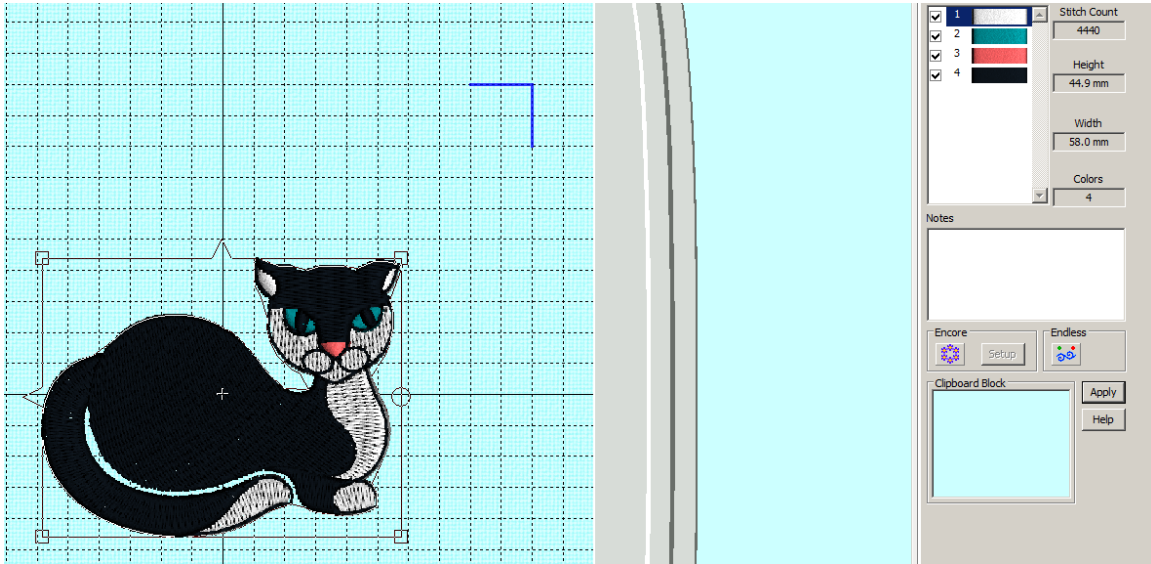


## Changing density in a design with 4D Extra's edit

Let's say you have a design and you know it's too dense and you don't have any software to change the density.



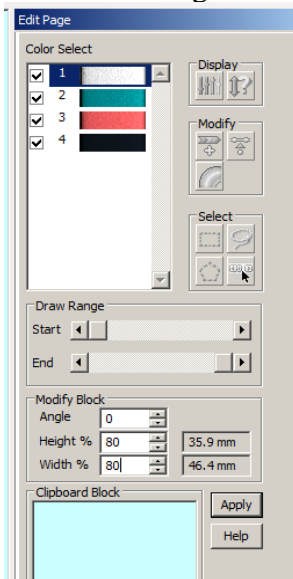
Notice the stitch count is 4440.

Click on the “edit tab” and touch the “resize” icon on the toolbar to make sure you have



hollow handles on the outline box around the design.

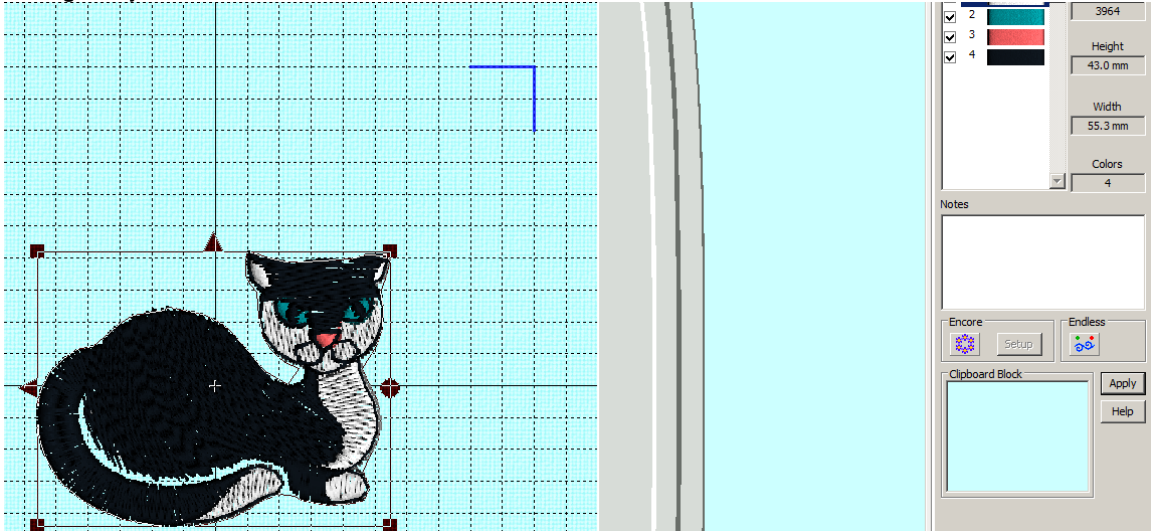
Under the “select” section, touch the “make block from visible area and the “modify block” becomes active. Type 80% in the height and the width and click “apply”. This means the design will be 80% of the original size but the stitch count is less now.



Then touch the resize/rescale icon again so you have (solid corners).

In the select box, choose the “make block of visible area” and this time type in 120 in both height and width and click “apply”. This will make the design back to normal size but with less stitches.

Touch the “design” tab and you will see the size is back to normal but the stitch count has changed by about 500 stitches.



It's up to you to decide the % of change to get less stitches.
