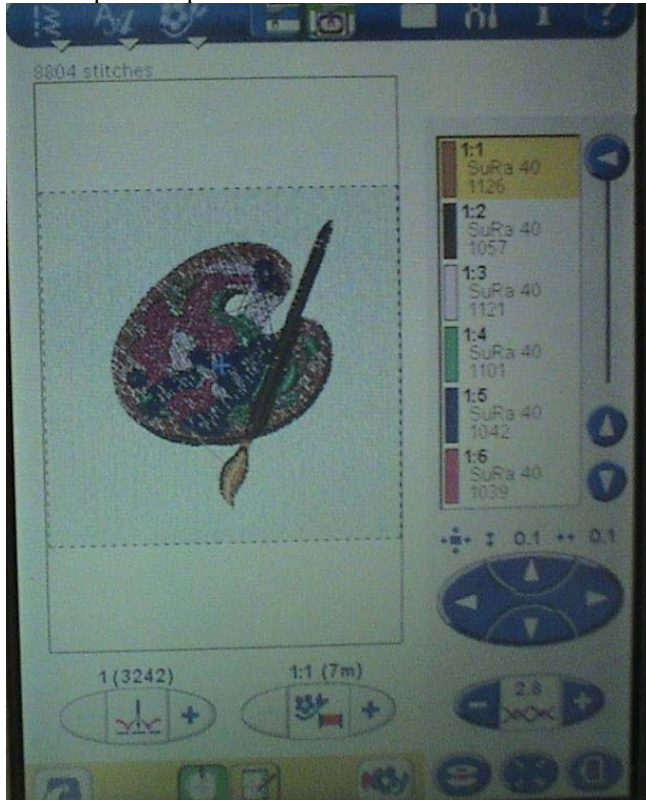


DSE Go To Embroidery Stitch Number *by Jan Henning*

Update 12124 gave us some new stitches in several categories but it also gave us a new feature to be able to tell how much time each color of an embroidery will take to stitch out and let us fast forward to a certain stitch.

So, let's take a look at the screen with an embroidery on it. We will bring up the design and attach the correct hoop and then touch the "embroidery icon" which you see is highlighted in green. It's the picture of a hoop with a plus in the center.



At the top left of the screen, you will see how many stitches are in the whole design.

Look to the right and you will see the colors in the design in the order they will stitch out.

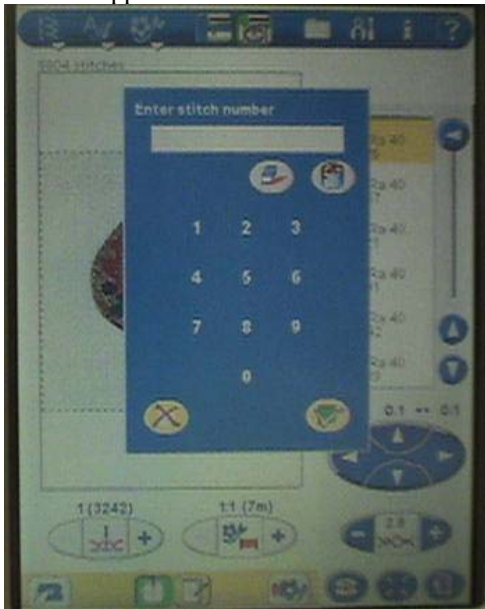
Below the picture, you will see the "stitches icon" "1 (3242)". There will be a minus on the left and a plus on the right. We can touch the Plus to fast forward some stitches and the minus to go backwards.

The "1" represents the first stitch and (3242 means how many stitches are in that first color. In the center of that icon, you will see a needle. This is the **"Go to" feature**. Instead of touching the Plus on that icon, you touch the center and type in the exact stitch you want.

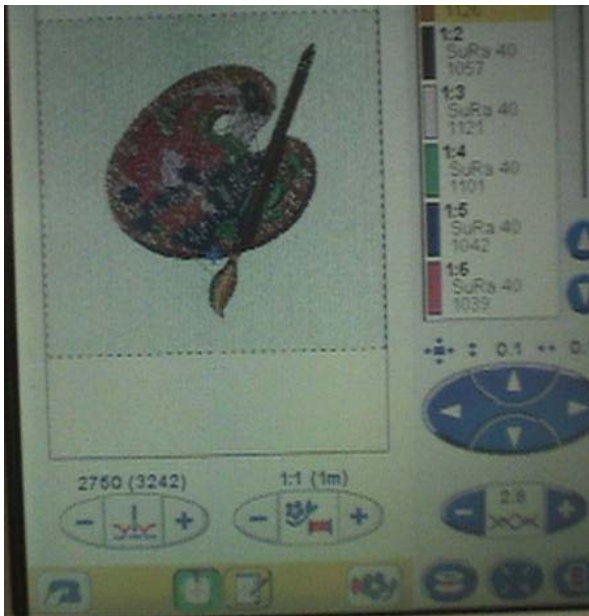
To the right of that icon is another icon called "color advance". It is showing 1:1 (7m). This means color #1 of the **first** design you put on the screen. If you had put **two** on the screen and you finally came to **those** colors, then a #2 would be seen there.

The # in brackets means the amount of time it will take to stitch that color. As you get to each color, it will tell you the time to stitch out that color.

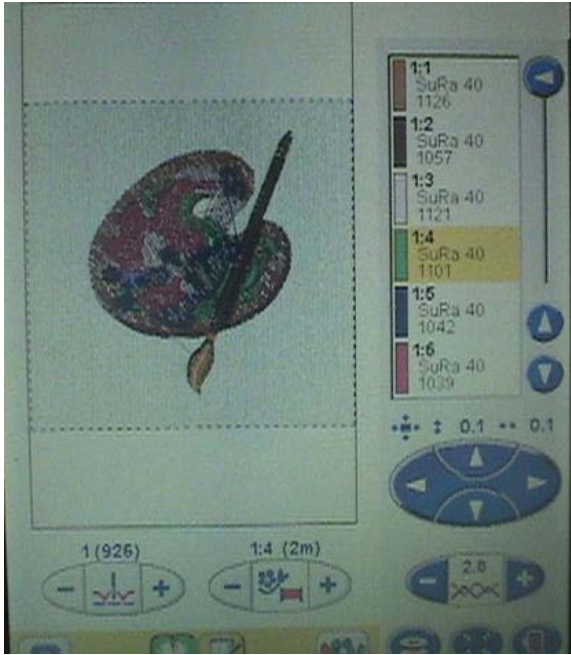
Now, I am going to click on the “Go to” which is the center of the “stitches icon” to show you the pop up that will appear.



Notice the first color has **3242 stitches** but **I want to jump to stitch # 2750**. I just touch 2, 7, 5, 0 and then touch the “check” to confirm that choice. The picture reflects the change and the hoop moves to that stitch.



If the stitch I wanted to jump to was in color # 4, I would touch the color #4 in the color bar. It shows **926 stitches** and **I want it to go to color # 810**. Notice the “color advance” icon now reflects #4. I could have touched the Plus to the right of the spool and advanced to color # 4 if I wanted to.



I click on the **“go to” and touch 8, 1, 0** and check it and it jumps to that stitch in that color.
