

Instructions playing my tutorial DVDs

People write and ask me how to play the DVDs on their computer or DVD player. It really depends what program you have.

You can also click on “start, programs, Windows Media Player OR Windows Media Center or whatever DVD reader program you have. Click on the opening picture.

1. Windows Media Player:

I have Vista on this computer. When I insert my DVD in my computer drive, Windows Media Player automatically opens. Yours may give you a selection of programs to choose from.

Click on the opening picture. Double click on right side of the screen to see the chapters under title I. (I only use Title 1)

Double click on the chapter you want to view. The chapters will remain on the screen so you can click from chapter to chapter. My XP computer has a different version and the chapters automatically show up. You just have to try to figure out how yours works. Play with the control panel.

2. My husband has a DVD player program that he loves called “Power DVD”. This only cost \$6.99 and well worth the money.

3. Windows Media Center:

Click on the opening picture to start the DVD.

Place cursor on bottom of screen to see the control panel. These controls may disappear after awhile. Each time you need them, just place the cursor on the bottom of the screen.

Chapters do not appear on the screen but it’s very easy to change chapters.

The “control panel” has a Center ball which is the “play/pause.”

On the left side of the ball is the chapter reverse and on the right side is the Chapter forward.

When you click on either of those, it will show which chapter will appear. Just keep clicking on the forward button to advance to the chapter you want.

4. Sony DVD player connected to my TV

I have a Sony DVD player that I hook up to my TV. You will have to read your instructions for your player.

When mine starts, I click on the picture to start the player. If I want to change chapters, I just touch the #'s on my remote control such as 5 for Chapter 5, 7 for Chapter 7, etc.

I haven’t figured out a way to have the chapters stay on the screen so I can just click on the chapter I want.
