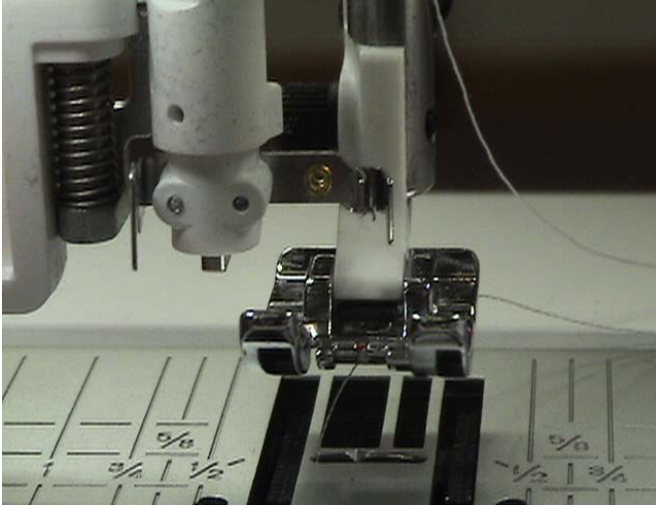


Diamond needle threader *by Jan Henning*

I removed the needle so you could get a good view of the hook in the center of the needle threader. It is to the left of the outside longer metal piece and looks like a crooked finger.

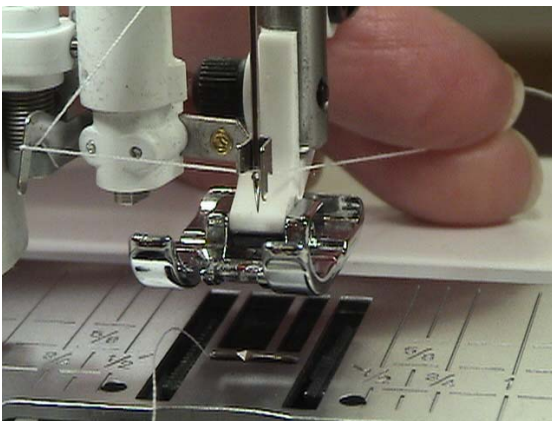


When you want to use the threader, you press down on the white lever on the left. Push all the way down so the hook of the threader will penetrate the eye of the needle.

Bring the thread from the guide above the needle and then under that metal hook on the left and then over it.

Then you take the thread straight across and under the hook in the threader and slowly release the white lever so that the hook in the threader can grab the thread.

(I'm trying to use the camera at the same time so I am using my left hand fingers to hold the thread back so you can see the threading. Normally, I would use my left hand for pressing down on the lever and my right hand to bring the thread to the needle.)



The needle threader should not be used on needles smaller than 70. It cannot be used with the twin, triple, wing needles or when the sensor buttonhole foot is attached.

If the threader doesn't align with the eye of the needle, touch the needle/up/down once to lower it and again to raise it and it should put the needle in the proper position for threading.
