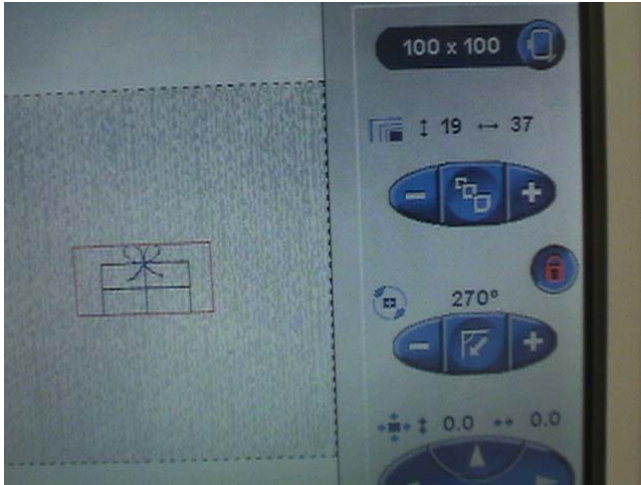


Omnigram designs on DSE

Attach your embroidery unit and choose the “favorites” menu and choose the **Xmas package design**. Close the screen and the package appears on the screen.

Choose the 100 X 100 hoop size. Touch the “rotation” button in the center 3 times to see 270 degrees.



Notice the coordinates just below the rotation icon is 0.0 and 0.0. This means the design is centered on the horizontal and vertical axis of the design area.

Click on the 3 colored balls on the lower right side of the screen and click on the “Grid” icon and then click on the icon that is 2 flowers as shown in the picture to return to the embroidery designs function screen.



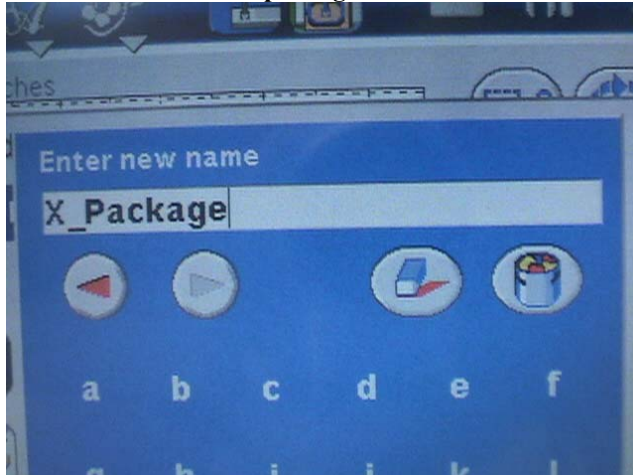
Use the “up arrow” in the coordinate icon to move the design straight up until it says **31.0 and 0.0**. It’s still centered but now it’s moved 31.0 above the horizontal center of the design area.

Touch the “x2” icon at the top right of the screen to duplicate the first design. Then use those coordinate arrows to move the design to the left and below the first design so the coordinates are **11.0 and -19.0** (negative). You can move the design faster if you touch it, but you might move another one accidentally.

Touch the “x2” icon again and move this one to the right so the coordinates are **11.0 and 19.0**

Click on the “save icon” (flower with red arrow as shown in the picture above.) Notice the name is “new design.vp3.

Touch the blue dot at the end of that name and a screen will pop up to rename the design. Touch the trash can icon at the top right to delete the name and then touch the first letter of the new name and then touch the small letter “a” icon at the bottom to get the rest in small letters and continue choosing the letters for the name “X package”.

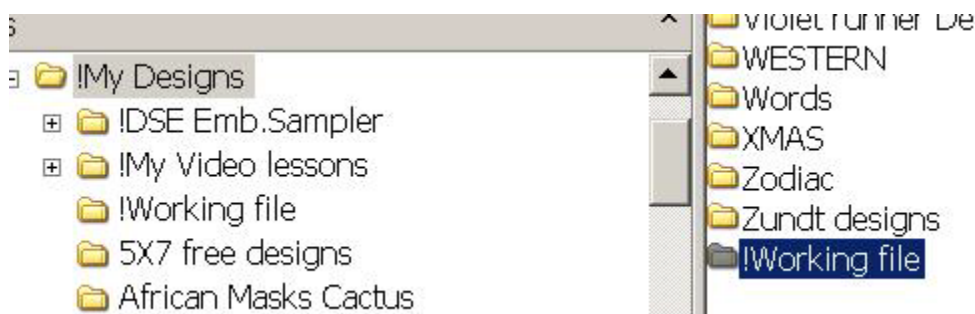


Close that screen when done and then choose the “device” icon and open the device and save to the stick. You can save this to your “my designs” folder on the sewing machine too if you like.

The machine will stop for a color change after each package. If you want them all the same, touch the “stop” button to remove the color changes. 12 Wt thread on top and normal sewing thread in the bobbin is really nice. Size 14 needle.

Computer playtime

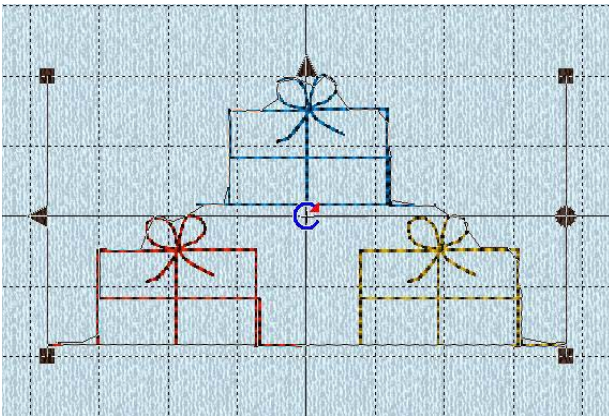
Open the “explorer” and make a new folder under the “my designs” folder called “!Working File”. Be sure to type the “exclamation” mark first so it will appear at the top of that folder.



Attach the stick to the computer. Find that design we saved and drag it to the Working file folder so we can play with it.

Open the 3D Embroidery Studio and choose the 100 X 100 hoop and bring up that design from the “!Working file”. The first thing you will notice is that isn’t centered so let’s take care of that. Move the design so the point of the mirrors are on the center horizontal and center vertical lines on the screen.

Then let's change the colors so each package will be a different color. Then click on the "center design" icon so the first and last stitches are centered. Save the design again and you can delete the original..



Now, with the design still on the screen, touch the "rotate 90" icon, so the packages are sideways and touch the horizontal mirror so they will be facing to the right.

Change the hoop size to "endless 100 X 170". Then click on the "endless" icon just above the notes area and choose "top, corner, both, repeat and color sort" and click OK. You now have an endless hoop embroidery for doing some borders on towels, pillow cases, children's tops, slacks, etc.
