

**Xmas Omnigram stitches saved as designs in vp3 format.**

See my website for “mini lessons” and look for the files **Xmas Stitches and Omnigram**. The first will show you how to get them to your machine’s U menu and the 2<sup>nd</sup> is a tutorial on a way to use one of those stitches to make an endless hoop design.

Viking gave us those Xmas omnigram stitches to **add to our U menu** but they are in sp3 format and if we want to save them as designs in vp3 format, we can do that too. It’s just a little more work but you might want to use those designs in other ways.

Attach the embroidery unit and turn on the machine.

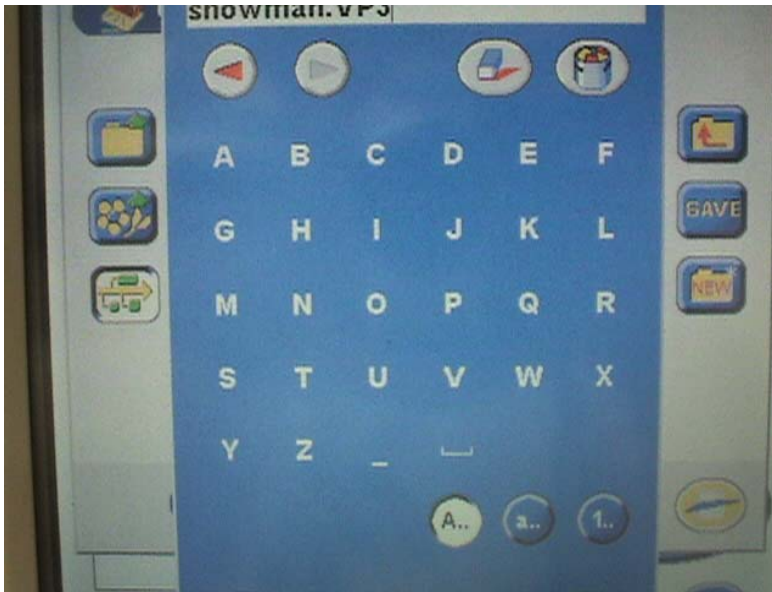
Click on the **U menu** where the stitches are located and click on the first stitch so it appears on the screen and then touch the checkmark at the bottom right to close that screen.

Touch the “blue flower with the red arrow” which is the “save” at the lower right of the screen.



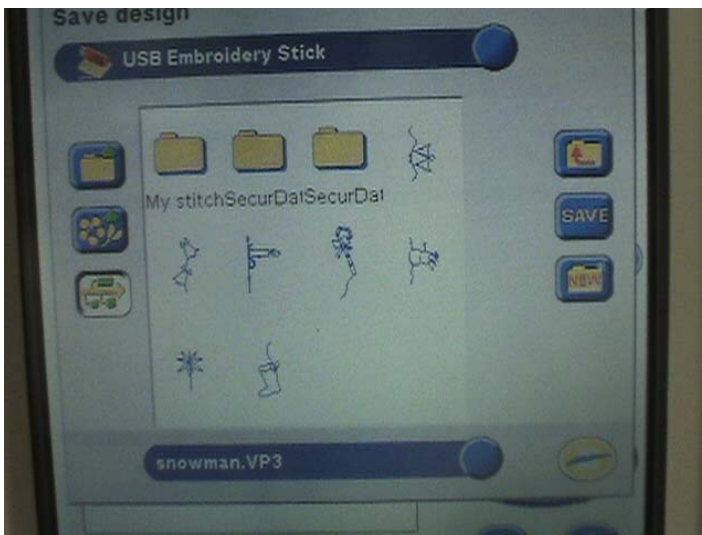
The name of the previous design may appear. Touch the blue ball at the end of that name window to get the Enter new name screen.

Touch the trash can icon next to the eraser to delete the whole name.



Then touch each letter for the new name. I usually just use the small letters. Touch the checkmark icon to confirm the name and a new screen appears .

Notice I have chosen the “embroidery stick” by clicking on the device icon on the left and clicked on “open” so it can accept the new file. When you click on save, it will be the next design.



The screen with the design will reappear and you should touch the “delete” at the top right to remove that design.

Then go back to the U menu and choose the next stitch and follow the same procedure.
