

## Xmas 2008 machine stitches by Janice Henning

This is the link to the Holiday stitches. Below the red package, download the stitches for the machine or machines you own and unzip them and then transfer those stitches to your stick.

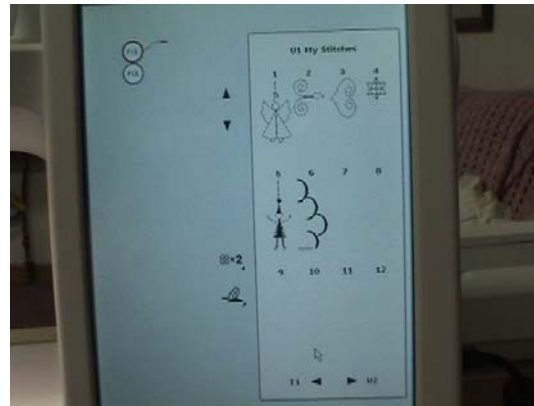
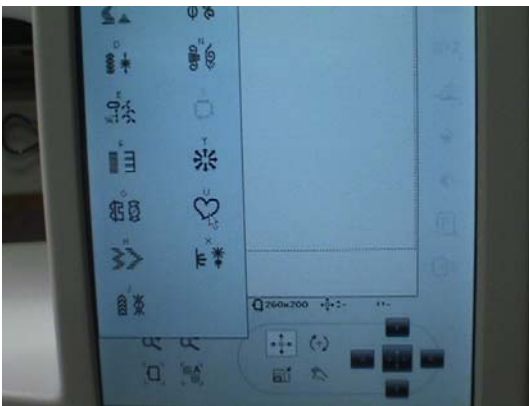
Now, let's go to the Diamond and read the stick and put those designs on the machine

You must open File Manager and click on "devices" and then choose the stick with the stitches on it.

Then load the stitch on the screen and click on the heart icon (U menu) at the bottom of the screen to save the stitch and choose the space on the screen where you want to save the stitch.

Converting "machine stitches" into vp3 designs.

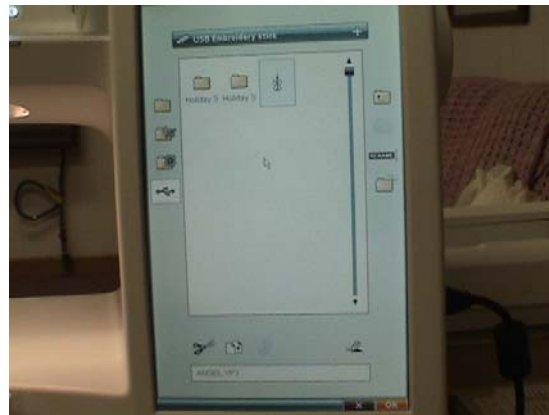
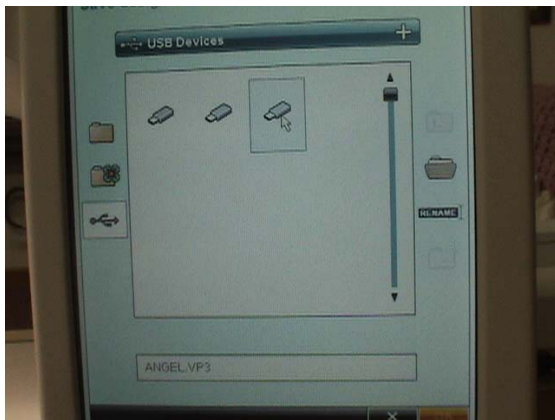
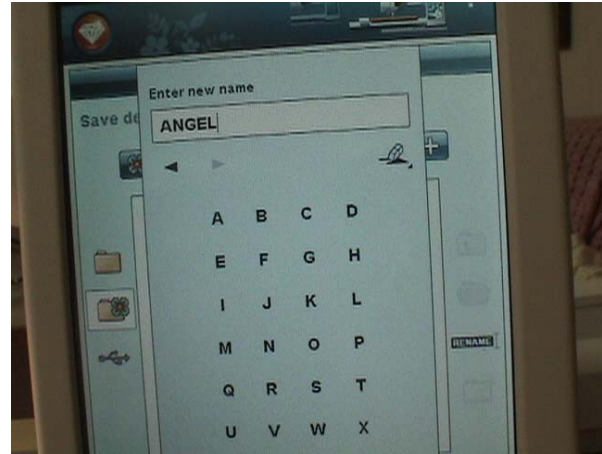
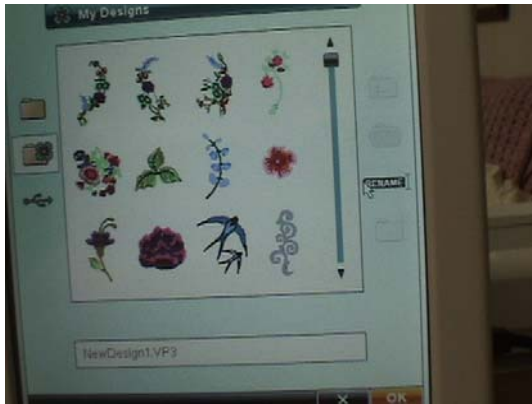
But, if you want those stitches to be saved as vp3 format so you can use them in 4D, you can do that too. The sewing machine must be in embroidery mode. Open the U menu and choose the angel stitch.



It will appear on the embroidery screen. Click on the "save icon". Picture with arrow pointing to it.

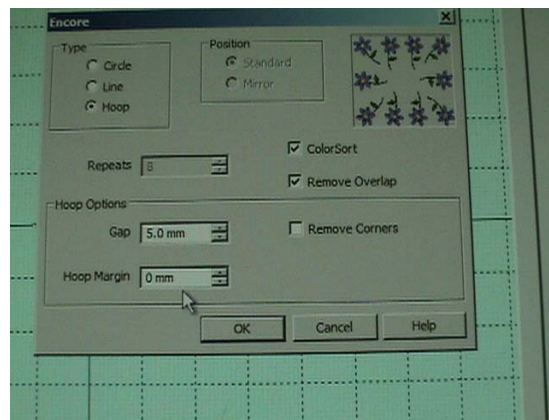
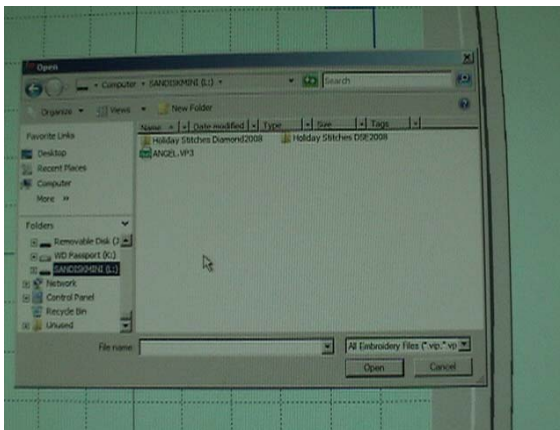


Click on "rename" and to name it "angel". The folder at the top may not be the stick, so click on "devices" and choose the stick and open it and click on Ok to save.



Click on "rename" to rename the designs as Angel.

Put the stick in the computer and click on the drive holding the stick and click on the angel design to bring it up on the 4D embroidery screen. Choose the hoop size you want and then click on encore I chose a gap of 5.0 so the angel would be spread apart and clicked on OK. Notice I chose Hoop under Type



Right click somewhere on the screen to complete the encore feature.
