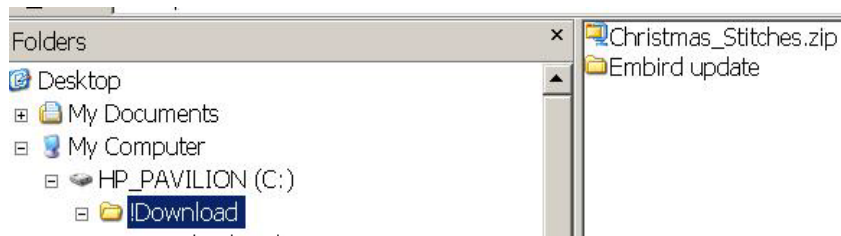
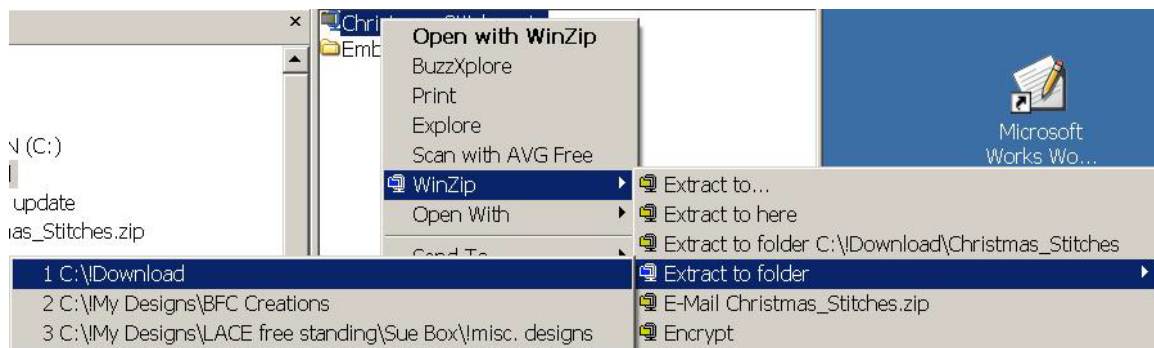


## Designer SE Xmas stitches

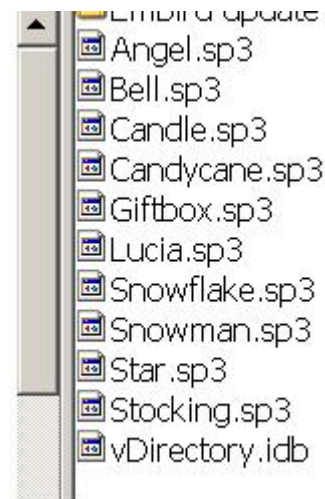
I've downloaded the file to my "download folder".



Right click on file to unzip. I have Win zip.



These are the files we unzipped.



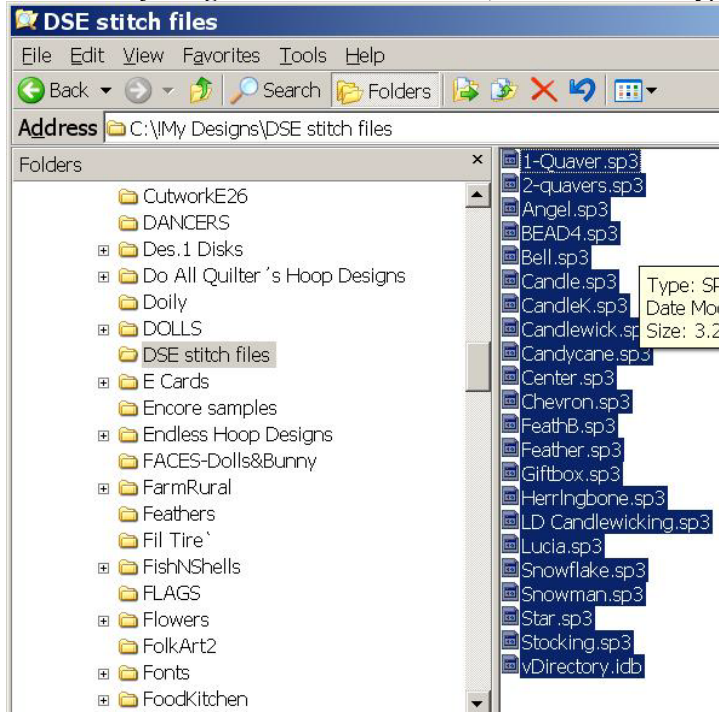
We need to do is transfer them to the stick and save them in a file so we can find them on the computer each time we have to update the machine, since updating wipes them all out of the "my stitches" file.

### SAVING ON THE COMPUTER

So, let's put them in a folder on our hard drive first.

Open the explorer and create a new folder under the "my designs" folder. Even though these aren't designs, it's easier to remember where they are.

Click on **“my designs”** folder and then **“file, new folder”** and type in **“DSE stitch files”**.



Hold down the control and A key on the keyboard at the same time to highlight all the files. Then either drag them over to the DSE stitch file folder or click on “edit, copy” .

Then click on the DSE stitch file folder and click on “edit, paste” and they will now be in the correct folder.

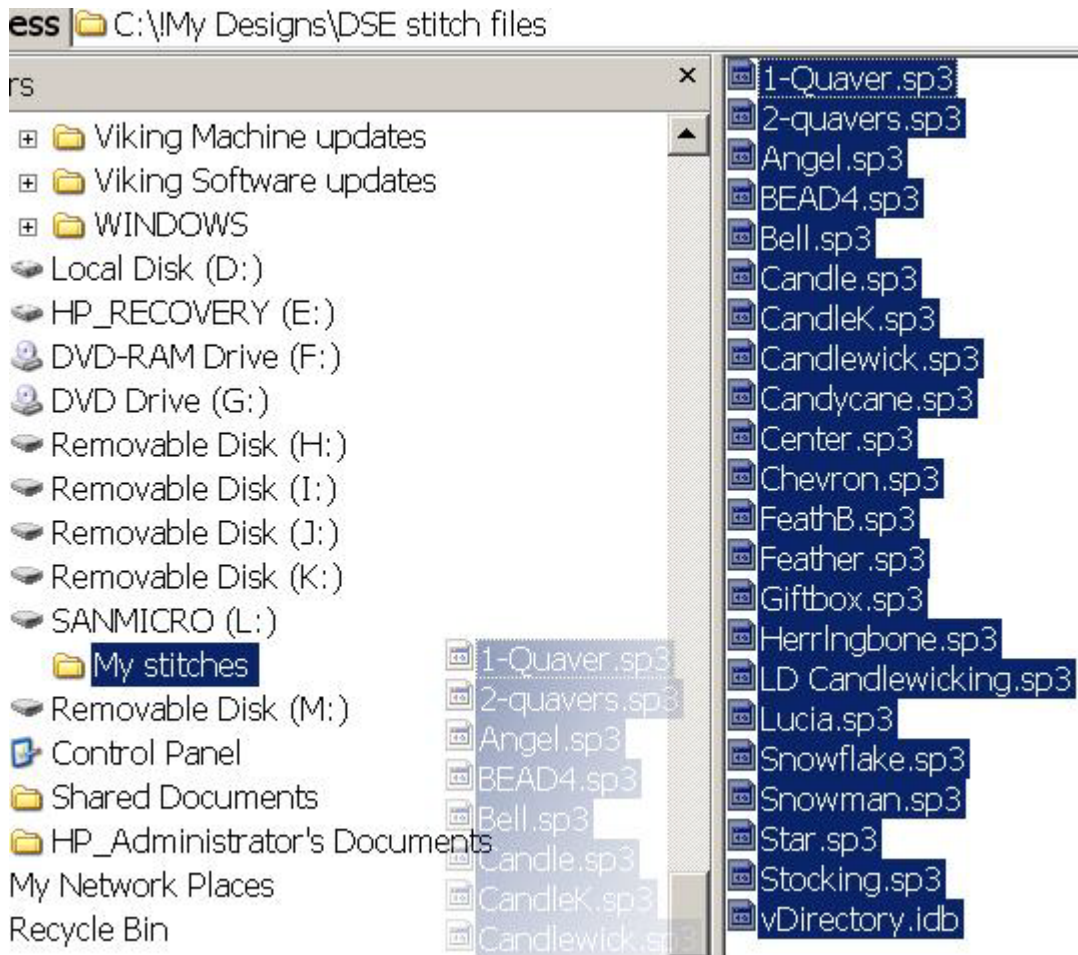
### **Embroidery stick**

Insert the stick into the USB port. Scroll down to find the port the stick is inserted into. First, let’s make sure we have a folder on the stick too so they won’t be mixed up with any designs we might have on the stick.

**Click on the drive that holds the stick and click on “file, new folder” and type in “My stitches”.**

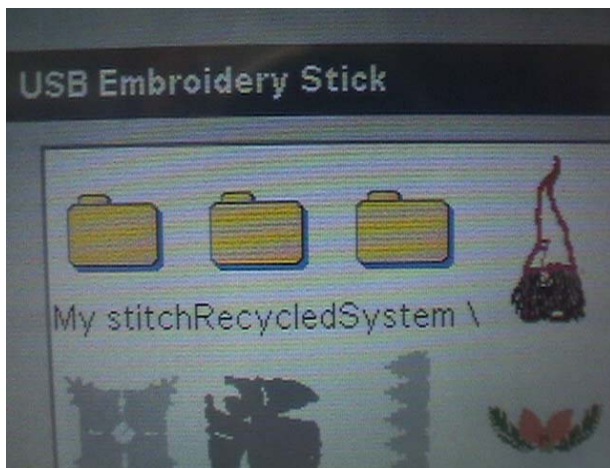
Click on the folder that holds those stitches and highlight all of them again and then drag them to the new folder you just made on that stick.

I had some other stitches in “my stitches” so I am transferring them too.

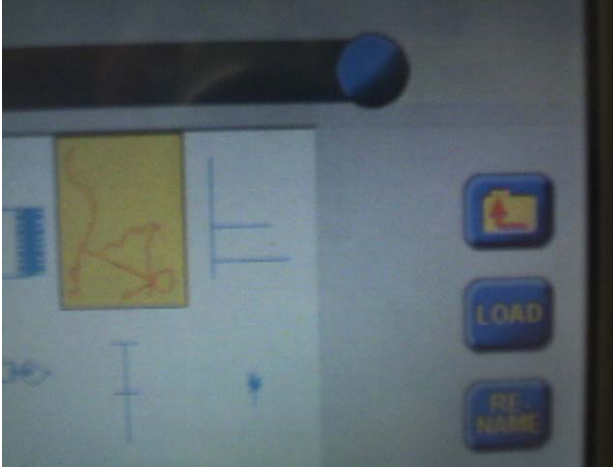


**Now we can put those stitches in “My stitches” in the DSE too.**  
Have the machine in the sewing mode.

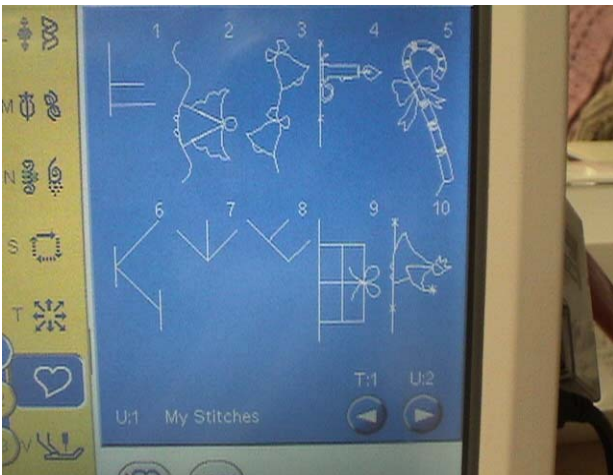
Then go to your machine and insert the stick and click on **"file manager"** to locate that stick and open it. Then click on **“my stitches”** folder and click on **“open”**.



Click on the first stitch and click on **“load”** and it will appear on the screen.



Touch the "save icon" and when the save screen opens, touch the first empty space and close that screen.



Then find the next stitch and do the same thing with each one.
