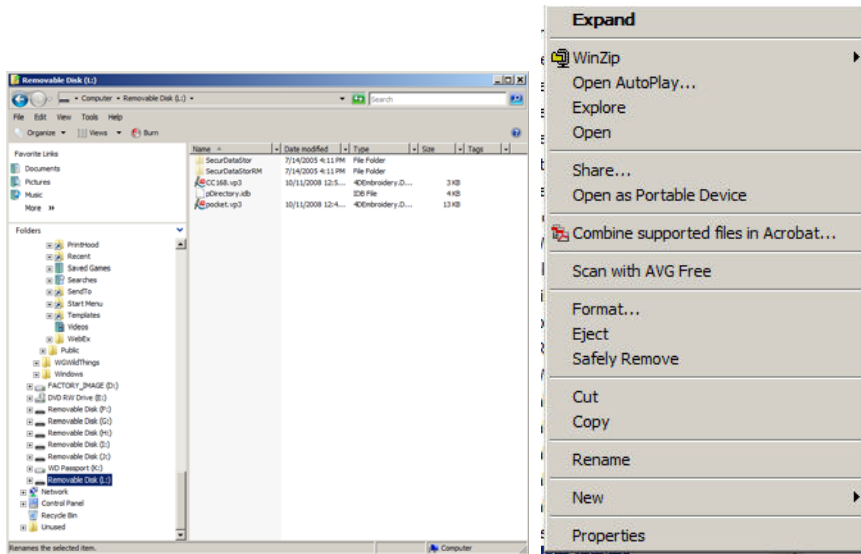


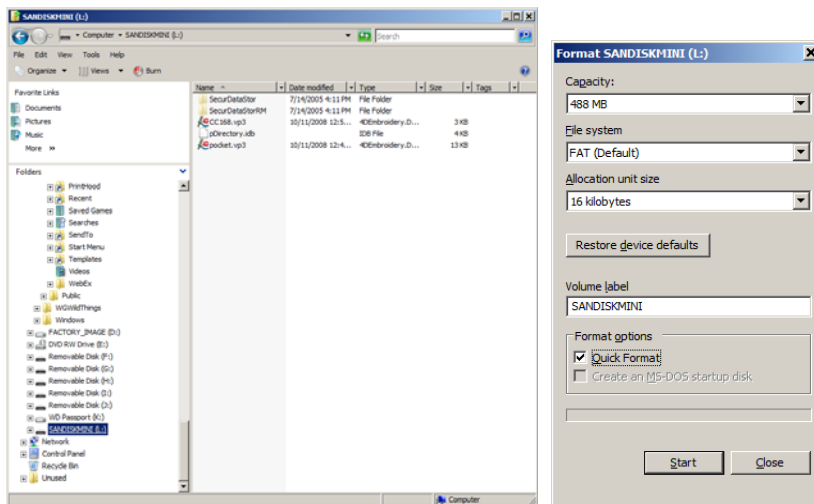
## Format your embroidery stick *By Janice Henning*

Insert your stick in the USB port. Hold down the Windows Log key and touch the E key on the keyboard to open the “explorer”. Scroll down to find the port/drive holding the stick.

Right click on the drive holding the stick. I like to name my sticks so I can recognize immediately when it’s in the port. I right click on the drive and click on “rename”.



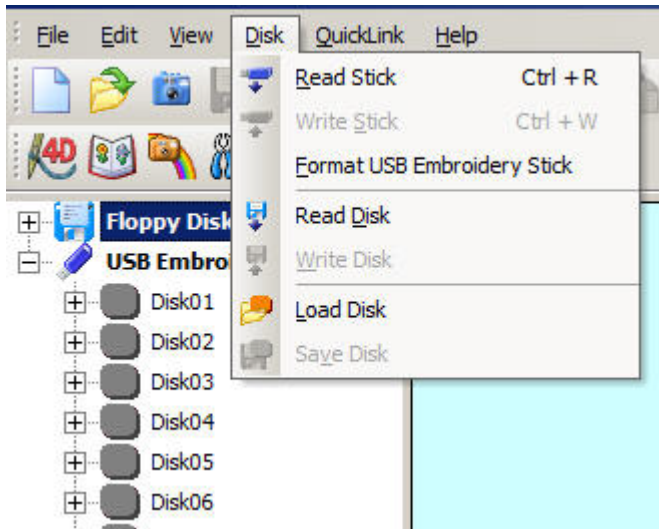
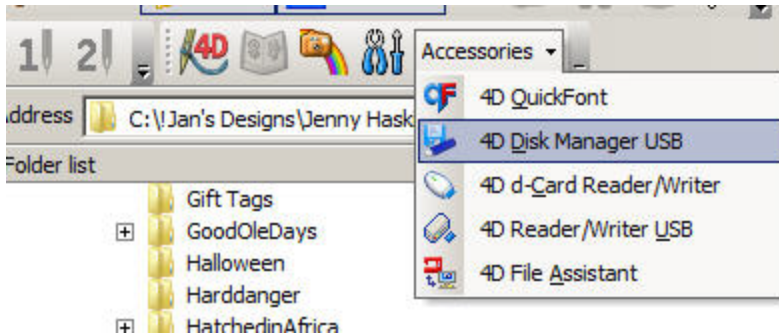
I’m naming it San Disk Mini. I “right click” on that drive again and this time, I click on “format”.



The stick is formatted which means it is cleared off.

You may also have to do it in Disk Manager.

Open your program and click on “accessories” on your toolbar or quick link toolbar to locate Disk Manager.



The stick is now formatted and when I select it, it shows it is empty.
