

Threading take-up lever from left to right

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Problems with looping and thread jumping out of take-up lever.

I had the most interesting conversation with my daughter, Marilyn.

She has a Viking 1+ and she only purchases polyester embroidery thread. She told me that she constantly had trouble with loops and the back always looked terrible and she had a problem with the thread jumping out of the take-up lever. I told her that I thought this thread was a bit slicker and it feeds faster through the tensions. She thought the same thing.

She decided to try something to see what would happen and in doing so, she said it eliminated all of those problems and the stitch out was perfect.

All she did was thread the machine as she normally does until she came to the take-up lever. Instead of just going through that take up lever from the right side, she instead went to the left side of it and brought the thread through the slot in the lever left to right.



This in effect made a crossover of the threads and then she continued to thread as normal. This solved the problem of looping and thread jumping out of the take-up lever.
